The Town of East Greenwich will be transitioning to an on-line application and renewal program that will change the way Dog Licenses are processed.

Here are a few things YOU can do to help with the transition:

- Provide a legible and valid email address (on the front).
- Make sure ALL information is correct.
- Include an updated rabies certificate so it can be scanned into the on-line portal.

Once this year's renewals are received, the staff in the Town Clerk's office will create an account and a record(s) for each owner and dog. Residents will be able to log-in to make changes as needed, upload rabies certificates and pay on-line using a credit card or an e-check.
