



## 2019 April Vacation Program

The Community Services and Parks Department, Recreation Division will be offering five days of trips and activities for children during the April Vacation week. Children may either sign up for a whole day of activities or simply a trip or a project. Registration is limited to East Greenwich residential taxpayers. Activities and trips have a limited enrollment.

**Registration begins on Monday, March 11, 2019**

**ONLINE REGISTRATION: EG Residents may sign up online for these activities as long as they have a preapproved online account.** To get a pre-approved account, submit an account request form to the office ahead of time. (Forms can be printed off the Town web site at [www.eastgreenwichri.com](http://www.eastgreenwichri.com).) Once verified you will receive an email with your password. If you need to set up your account, then act immediately so on the first day of sign-ups you are ready to go!

Already have an account and password, then you are all set to sign up on 3/11/19 at 8:45am by logging on to [www.eastgreenwichri.com](http://www.eastgreenwichri.com). *If you need to update your list of pick-up & release people or update any medical information you will need to stop at the office and fill out a change of information form. This cannot be done online.*

**PAPER REGISTRATION** forms are still accepted by mail or in person. Simply get your form to the office by the first day of registration and we will begin enrolling it lottery style on 1/28/19. Your best chance of getting your selection will be via the online process as classes will fill on a first come basis and the office can only process forms one at a time. One form per child and one envelope per family please.

A computer print-out will acknowledge receipt of your form. If you do not receive one then call us. All late walk-in registrations will begin on Wed, March 13, 2019.

**REFUNDS:** NO refunds will be given after **4/5/19**, unless the activity is canceled. If you or your child becomes injured, ill, unavailable, disinterested, etc. after this date and your spot can be filled with someone on our waitlist then you may receive a partial refund. Please notify the office as soon as possible so that we can attempt to reach someone.

**CAMPERSHIPS** will be provided to those on public assistance. Please submit your registration form to the office before the 1<sup>st</sup> registration day along with proof of need (ie. housing statement, SNAP card, SSI documentation, etc.)

**CREDIT CARDS ACCEPTED:** All credit card transactions will be charged a processing fee and are billed directly to your credit card. The processing fee is 2.5% of the total charge or a minimum of \$1.95. Processing fees are not refundable.

**Monday, April 15, 2019**

**Kidz Art Workshop:** This morning Julie leads a mixed media workshop at the Recreation Office. She starts by working with each art technique separately, before combining them all together to create a scenic lakefront picture. Wear clothes to create in.

**Period Pastimes:** What was leisure time like for children of the past? Students discover the answer to this question on the lawn at Casey Farm, where they solve riddles, make a toy to bring home, and play a variety of historic games including Knuckle Bones, Graces and more! Wear sneakers and jackets for outdoor play.

**Hall at Patriots Place:** Celebrate the Patriots sixth championship as the group explores a dazzling array of interactive multimedia exhibits and artifacts. Can you jump as high as Devin McCourty? See if you can kick a 45 yard field goal.

**Wednesday, April 17, 2019**

**Chepatchet Farm:** Get up close and personal at this local farm! Visit the maple syrup shack and learn how it's made. Explore a chicken coop to learn the significance they play on a farm. Enjoy the petting zoo where you'll get to feed the animals, as well as create a project of your own. Wear sturdy shoes for exploring the farm.

**Nature Detectives:** Taking place at Fisherville Brook, participants explore and use their senses and detective skills as they investigate the forest and fields and engage in games and activities. Wear hiking shoes or sturdy sneakers and a jacket. Apply insect repellent prior to coming.

**Thursday, April 18, 2019**

**Rocket Science:** Join Mad Science for a workshop called "Rocket Science". Learn the principles of rocket flight, and then head outside for an actual rocket launch! Participants make their own launch able rocket to take home. Program held at Recreation office.

**R1 Indoor Kart Racing:** Using “Mini Karts” the group races around the track, followed by bowling and a pizza party! To participate a R1 Karting waiver must be returned to the Recreation Office.

### Friday, April 19, 2019

**New Bedford Whaling:** Check out the life size blue whale skeleton and model whaling boat on display as well as other exhibits at this New Bedford attraction. Participants are sure to have a whole new appreciation for what the whaling industry did for New England.

**Kingstown Bowl:** Spend the afternoon bowling at Kingstown Bowl. Try your luck at knocking down all the pins. Participants must wear socks and sneakers. Children may bring extra money for vending machine snacks.

#### **EXTENDED DAY OPTION-Fee: \$10.00/ day (M, T, W, Th., F)**

The Recreation Office at 1127 Frenchtown Road will be open at 8:30am and close at 5:00pm for those children needing a longer day. Children can come in early, stay through lunch and the break period, and stay late by signing up for the Extended Day. **If you're just staying between the two activities, then you must also sign up for the Extended Day Option.** Children are to be dropped off at the office after 8:30am and before the 1<sup>st</sup> trip time. The fee includes supervision before and after the trip or slated activity as well as opportunities to do crafts, play games, play outdoors, etc. and an afternoon snack. Children must pay and sign up for the above list of events. NO alternative activities are planned. Please dress your children for outdoor play (jackets, boots, mittens, etc.). Children must bring a bag lunch & drink each day.

**HOW TO SIGN UP ON-LINE FOR EXTENDED DAY:** When registering yourself on-line you will be prompted to sign up for the Extended Day Option when signing up for the afternoon activity. You should click “yes” if you have registered for that morning’s activity and will be dropping off at 8:30am and/or picking up no later than 5:00pm ; or staying in between activities on the same day. If one of the two activities on the same day is full, then you cannot stay for the whole day. Contact the office for some options to participate for a portion of the day.
