

TRANSFER STATION SERVICES

All curbside collection items are also accepted at the Transfer Station.

Location:

The East Greenwich Transfer Station is located on Crompton Avenue between the Town Boat Ramp and the Sewage Treatment Plant.

Regular Hours: Saturdays, 8 A.M.– 4 P.M.

Permits Required:

- Cars registered to town residents can receive a Transfer Station Sticker free of charge from the Department of Public Works (D.P.W.) located in the lower level of the School Administration Bldg. at 111 Peirce St.
- Residents' noncommercial pickup trucks and utility trailers **require a ticket per visit.** Twelve tickets are available annually for residents only. (obtain tickets at D.P.W.)
- D.P.W. is open Monday through Friday, 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM. **Residents must bring vehicle registration to D.P.W.** Questions? Call 886-8620/886-8621

Procedures:

- **Prior to arrival at transfer station,** items must be sorted/segregated.
- Items must be placed in the designated container. Look for the label/sign.
- When unloading, please turn vehicle off and **promptly empty vehicle.**
- Continue through as directed.

DROP-OFF FOR RECYCLING

Recycling Bin items, such as:

Clean and dry mixed paper:

- Newspaper and inserts
- Magazines and catalogs
- Junk mail and envelopes
- Thin cardboard
- Cardboard boxes flattened
- Brown paper bags
- Wrapping and tissue paper
- Phone books
- Shredded paper in double clear plastic bags

Mixed recyclables:

- Aluminum and Tin cans
- Plastic containers (up to 5 gallons)
- Glass Bottles and Jars
- Foil and Pie Plates
- Metal lids
- Milk and Juice Cartons
- Juice boxes (no straws)

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED INCLUDE:

- Plastic bags
- Fluorescent Bulbs
- Household Batteries
- Fire Extinguishers
- Propane Tanks
- Paint cans
- Tires
- Computers/Electronics

DROP-OFF FOR RECYCLING

Bulky Items:

- Carpet, furniture.

Mattresses, Box Springs:

- Clean and dry

Metals:

- Metal items are accepted in designated container.
- **Lawnmowers – All fluids MUST be drained from engine.**

Motor Oil & Filters:

- Up to 5 gallons of used motor oil may be deposited in the oil “igloo” per visit.
- Oil filters are accepted. **Transmission fluid and antifreeze are not accepted.**

White Goods:

- Kitchen appliances, washers and dryers.
- **No Freon: refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers.** Call DPW for appointment for monthly curbside pickup.

Wood Products: Residents only may deposit:

- Building demolition waste **from their household only.**
- Broken wooden furniture.

Yard Waste:

- General yard waste including leaves, grass clippings, weeds, flowers, etc.
- Brush/Branches must be separated from general yard waste and placed in the designated container.
