



2010 February Vacation Program

The Parks & Recreation Department will be offering four days of trips and activities for area children during the February Vacation week. Children may either sign up for a whole day of activities or simply a trip or a project. Registration is limited to East Greenwich residential taxpayers. Camperships and reduced fees are available for those on public assistance.

REGISTRATION: Registration will begin by mail only on **Monday, February 1, 2010**. Forms will be entered on a random basis. One form per child and one envelope per family please. A computer print out will acknowledge receipt of your form. If you do not receive one then call us. All late **walk-in** registrations will begin on Wednesday, February 3, 2010. NO refunds will be given after **2/8/10** unless the activity is canceled. Some activities and trips have a limited enrollment or age group.

FULL DAY PROGRAM: The Parks & Recreation Office at 1127 Frenchtown Road will be open at 8:30am and close at 5:00pm for those children needing to stay all-day. Children are to be dropped off at the office after 8:30am and before the 1st trip time. The fee includes the trip or slated activity for the day as well as opportunities to do crafts, play games, play outdoors, etc. Children must participate in the following list of events. NO alternative activities are planned. Please dress your children for outdoor play (jackets, hats, mittens, snow boots, etc.) Children must bring a bag lunch and drink from home each day. Snacks will be provided in the afternoon.
