The Town of East Greenwich is currently accepting applications for the position of police officer. A qualified applicant must be at least 21 years of age, a resident of the State of RI with an active RI driver's license and have a high school diploma or equivalent. Applicants will undergo a vigorous screening process, including physical agility testing, written examination and oral interview, psychological and drug screenings. All persons who have previously applied are encouraged to re-apply. Preference will be given to those who possess a certificate from the Rhode Municipal Police Academy, along with a letter of good standing from an acting Chief of Police. Applications can be downloaded under the forms section of our website. They are also available at the kiosk in the lobby of the Police Dept., 176 First Avenue. Deadline for the return of applications to the Police Department is Friday, April 22, 2011 at 5:00pm.
