

# East Greenwich Recycling Mini A to Z

## A

- Appliances (large/white goods): Free curbside pickup, on a monthly basis. Call the DPW office at 886-8620 or 886-8621 for an appointment OR drop off at the Transfer Station.
- Appliances (w/ Freon): Free curbside pickup, on a monthly basis. Call the DPW office at 886-8620 or 886-8621 for an appointment.

## C

- Carpeting/Rugs: Free curbside pickup for bulky items, limit one item per week. Cut into manageable pieces. Place next to trash barrel OR drop off at the Transfer Station.
- Christmas Trees: Place curbside on your regular collection day during the scheduled weeks of January (see Collection Calendar on the DPW's website for the schedule), or drop off at the Transfer Station.
- Clothes and Shoes :
  - Big Brother/Big Sister (non-profit collection bin)
    - Crestar Picture Framing, 51 Liberty Street
  - Society of St. Vincent DePaul (non-profit)
    - Our Lady of Mercy School, 55 4th Avenue
  - Free recycling at yearly town events, call DPW at 401-886-8620 for details.
- Construction & Demolition Debris: From household only - Drop off at the Transfer Station.

## E

- E-waste:
  - Free recycling at yearly town events, call DPW at 401-886-8620 for details.
  - Small quantity drop off at Cartridge World, 776 Main Street, East Greenwich, Mon - Fri 9:00AM to 5:00PM, Sat 9:00AM to 4:00PM. Phone: 401-515-2011.

Items accepted include computers, laptops, monitors, routers, PDA's, cell phones, mice, keyboards, ink-jet printers, toner cartridges, CD/DVD players, radios, televisions, network equipment, wires, stereos, speakers, telephones, cameras, microwaves, small household appliances, and acid lead batteries including auto/marine and battery back-ups.

- Furniture, Appliances, Construction Materials (Paint, Lumber, Hardware, etc)

- Furniture, unusable: Free curbside pickup for bulky items, limit one item per week. Place next to trash barrel OR drop off at the Transfer Station.

## **I**

- Ink Cartridges: See E-Waste.

## **L**

- Leaves & Yard Waste: Place curbside on your regular collection day during April, May, October, November, and every other week June-September (see Solid Waste/Recycling Calendar for schedule) OR drop off at the Transfer Station.

## **M**

- Mattresses & Box Springs: Free curbside pickup, on a monthly basis. Call the DPW office at 886-8620 or 886-8621 for an appointment OR drop off at the Transfer Station.
- Medications: MedReturn bin at Police Station, 176 First Avenue
- Metals: Free curbside pickup, on a monthly basis. Call the DPW office at 886-8620 or 886-8621 for an appointment. Place next to trash barrel OR drop off at the Transfer Station. Items like lawn mowers must have the fluids drained.
- Motor Oil & Filters: Drop off at the Transfer Station.

- Plastic Pots for Plants: collection bin

- Rechargeable Batteries and Cellphones: collection bins
